

Shropshire Domestic Abuse Self-Referral Pathway

Are you worried that your behaviour is having a negative impact on your relationships, are you harming those you care about? If you are a male living in Shropshire and are concerned about your behaviour you can now make a self referral to Richmond Fellowships behaviour change programme.

We do not currently accept self-referrals made to us from persons that meet any of the following criteria:

- Currently subject of private law child arrangement applications
- Have been subject of private law child arrangements within the last 12-month period (from time of self-referral to the programme).
- Have been subject to public or private family law proceedings within the last 12-month period

We do currently accept self-referrals made to us from persons that meet the following criteria:

- Male 18 years or over
- A father or carer of child / children and doesn't have to be living with child.
- Accepting some level of responsibility or acknowledgement for domestic abuse
- No recent history of attempted strangulation perpetrated or attempts to kill
- Full contact details of victims involved (current or ex partners)
- Victim must engage with Integrated Support Services (ISS) for male to access to the programme
